## Flight Assistance For Children & Adults

Intercontinental and Hobby are the two Houston area airports that you can fly into. Listed below are the airlines / organizations that have in the past provided families with free or reduced medical airfare. The United Brachial Plexus Network, Inc. has a "Wings Program" that can assist you in getting free or reduced airfare by providing you with a letter from a non-profit organization when required. Contact UBPN, Inc. toll free at (866) 877-7004 or info@ubpn.org. It is helpful if you do some research first and find out which airlines have non-stop service to Houston. One easy way to do this is to check www.orbitz.com.

If your airline is not listed, call them directly and ask if they have a special program for medical airfare. It is common for airlines to donate unused mileage to children and families in need. Some airlines/ organizations donate seats for one parent and one child and some airlines donate seats for both parents and the child.
